In her book, *The Writing Revolution* Judith Hochman tells us that students' problems with reading comprehension, as well with writing essays, occur because they have not been taught systematically to write ... to which her book gives a step-by-step guide.

Sioux Government & Warfare

5. Subordinating conjunctions II – Although, If, Since

Subordinating clauses do not just help you make the sentence more complex, they allow you the sentence to convey more complex ideas, for example:

"Although the Indigenous Nations fought wars which included massacres and many deaths, the general opinion was that fighting to the death was stupid."

"If a direct attack involves too much risk, the Indian's next concern is to get possession of the horses."

"Since the harsh environment forced them to work together, there were no written laws or prisons."

You will note from these examples that the subordinating clause (which need not, but in these examples comes at the start of the sentence) allows the sentence to introduce a related, but different idea – a different opinion of war, a different plan of attack, a different approach to law & order.

This is essential when you are writing argumentative answers, which require you weigh conflicting ideas (such as 'which was the more important reason').
